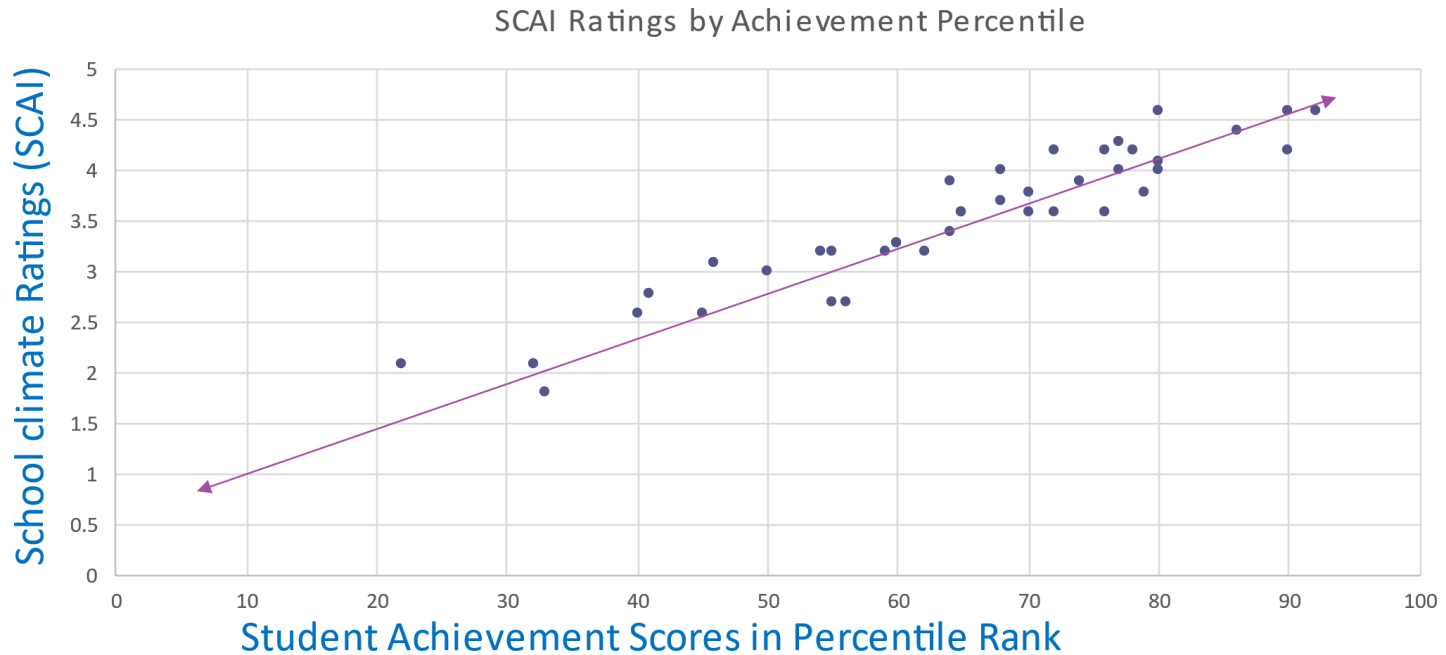

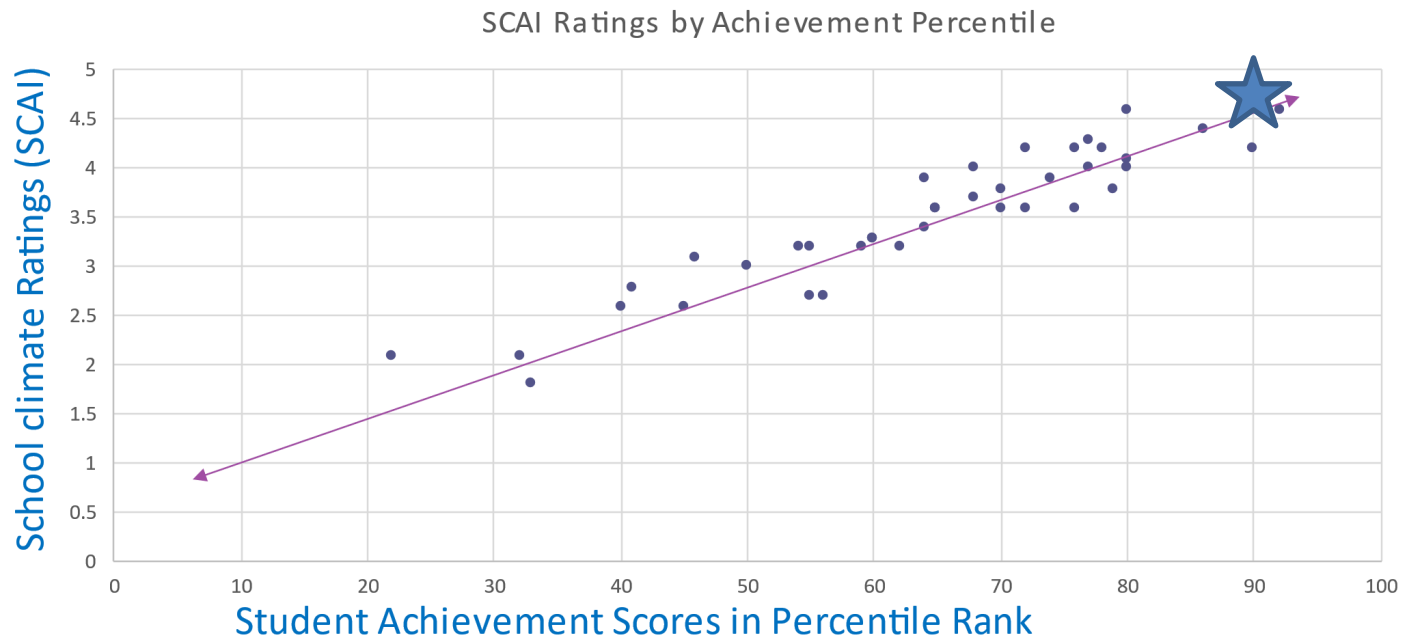
SCAI scores show a high correlation to measures of student performance.
